WHEREAS, the Santa Clara County Office of Education partners with many early childhood providers and non-profit and government organizations through the Strong Start Initiative to leverage resources and create momentum in our community to support universal access to high-quality early learning; and

WHEREAS, through Head Start, Early Head Start, State Preschool, and Educare of Silicon Valley, the County Office provides over 3,000 students and their families with a strong preschool experience because school readiness is an achievement gap closing strategy and an investment in our future; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Clara County Board of Education and County Superintendent of Schools join the National Association for the Education of young Children (NAEYC) in proclaiming April 24 - 28, 2017, as the Week of the Young Child and encourages residents of Santa Clara County to support the needs of young children in our community.
