JOIN US for the 2009 Standards-Based Tests in Spanish (STS) Standard Setting Workshops

ETS and the California Department of Education are looking for knowledgeable, current California teachers who are bilingual and biliterate to work with test developers at standard-setting workshops for the Standards-Based Tests in Spanish (STS). The STS is part of the California Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) Program and is developed for and administered to Spanish-speaking English-language learners in grades 2 through 11. The standard-setting process will ensure that test items are fair, and that appropriate cut scores and performance levels are determined for the tests. You'll also help review the STS test items and their data and make selections that will impact future reporting levels.

You can help us create fair and appropriate tests if you:

- Are bilingual and biliterate in Spanish.
- Have at least three years of experience teaching in either bilingual-education classrooms for Spanish-speaking students OR teaching course in reading/language arts or mathematics grades 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 to Spanish-speaking students.
- Have a bachelor's degree or higher in the subject areas of reading/language arts, mathematics and/or Spanish.
- Are knowledgeable about the California content standards and the capabilities of the students taking these tests.

ETS will cover your workshop-related travel and lodging expenses, and reimburse your school or district for the cost of a substitute teacher if your school is in session at the time of the workshop. This is also a great professional development opportunity.
