The iTELL project helps teachers explore how to optimize learning, enhance student engagement, and promote high levels of content knowledge for ELL students by infusing powerful technology-enhanced strategies into teaching and learning. Research-based strategies are utilized, which have been shown to improve teaching and enhance learning for EL students (based primarily on GLAD and SIOP), and then technology is embedded in those strategies to increase student interest and motivation.
