

The County Superintendent shall negotiate and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with each charter school approved by or assigned to the County Board of Education. If unable to reach agreement and sign an MOU with any charter school, the County Superintendent will recommend revocation of the school's charter, as described in AR 6232.

1.0 SPECIAL EDUCATION

The County Superintendent shall ensure that all children with disabilities enrolled in the charter school receive special education and designated instruction and services in a manner that is consistent with their individualized educational programs. In such cases, the County Superintendent will ensure that costs and funding for the special education shall be in compliance with the provisions of Education Code and shall not encroach upon County Office of Education funds.

2.0 CONTENT OF THE MOU

The MOU shall follow the template of Figure AR 6234-1, and shall incorporate any conditions set by the County Board of Education in approving or accepting the charter.

3.0 PUBLIC NOTICE OF MOU CONTENT

This Administrative Regulation and Figure AR 6234-1 shall be posted on the SCCOE Web site so that the public has full access to the content of the MOU.
