Recommended Action	Resolution to Continue Meeting Remotely in Accordance with AB 361

On March 17, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order N-29-20 that suspended the teleconferencing rules set forth in the Brown Act enabling legislative bodies to meet remotely. On September 16, 2021, the Governor signed AB 361 authorizing a legislative body subject to the Brown Act to continue to meet remotely using teleconference without compliance with the Brown Act teleconference rules if certain conditions are followed. On [September 21, 2021](#), the County Health Officer issued a recommendation, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, that public bodies continue to meet remotely. On November 30, 2021 and June 2, 2022 the Opportunity Youth Academy Governing Board passed Resolution No. 2289-5 authorizing virtual board meetings pursuant to AB 361.

The County Health Officer has recommended that legislative bodies continue to meet remotely to promote social distancing as one means to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. The Opportunity Youth Academy Governing Board has an important governmental interest in protecting the public health, safety, and welfare of those who participate in meetings of the various legislative bodies during COVID-19 and ensuring that all members of the public can participate safely in meetings of legislative bodies.

Recommended Action	Adoption of Opportunity Youth Academy's Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) for 2022-23

California Education Code sections 41507 and 41572 require each school to consolidate all school plans for programs funded through the Consolidated Application and Reporting System, into the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA).

The School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) is completed annually by school sites accepting federal funds. Through an educational partner engagement process including staff, students, and parents, OYA set goals and budgets to support student achievement and student and parent engagement. The SPSA goals are aligned with the OYA LCAP goals.

On 5-20-2022, the School Site Council reviewed and approved the SPSA to include updated budget information.
