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**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THIS YEAR’S REPORT:**

For the 2021 Williams Case school visits, SB 130 waived the requirement to have unannounced visits for 25% of the school sites on the identification list for 2021-22. The Williams team at Santa Clara County Office of Education began making plans in June 2021 to accommodate the current conditions of students and staff returning to campus with new health and safety guidelines. Our team worked closely with district and site administrators to gather all the information needed to create this report.

**Introduction**

Williams v. California was a class-action lawsuit filed May 2000 claiming the state’s poorest children were being denied equal educational opportunities. The suit alleged that public school students lacked equal access to instructional materials, safe and decent school facilities, and qualified teachers. Settlement of the lawsuit in August 2004 resulted in a package of laws — known as the “Williams legislation” — ensuring that all students have the basics of a quality education.

This report summarizes the 2020 and 2021 findings of specific monitoring responsibilities of the County Superintendent of Schools as identified by the Williams Settlement and subsequent legislation in four key areas:

1. **Instructional materials** (2021)– Students must have sufficient access to standards aligned materials or textbooks;
2. **Facilities maintenance** (2021)– Schools must be in “good repair” (safe, clean, and functional);
3. **Teacher vacancies** (2020)– Report of unfilled positions at Williams schools; and
4. **Public reporting** (2020) – School Accountability Report Cards (SARC) must include information on Williams; non-compliance with Williams must be incorporated in Uniform Complaint Procedures and classroom posting of notices.

**Instructional Materials: Students must have sufficient access to standards aligned materials or textbooks.**

All Decile 1-3 schools must be visited within the first four weeks of the school year. A sampling methodology is used, in which at least one in every five classes in every section, by grade and/or by subject, is visited by a Williams monitor to determine that each student has a district adopted, standards aligned textbook for use in class and at home.

Facilities Maintenance: Schools must be in “good repair” (safe, clean and functional)

All Decile 1-3 schools are subject to facilities inspection by staff from the SCCOE. The inspections are conducted by teams using the Facilities Inspection Tool (FIT) developed by the California Department of Education’s Office of Public School Construction to determine if a school is in “good repair” as defined by Education Code Section 17002(d) and to provide a rating of its condition. The FIT was first used in 2007 and was revised in 2009. The FIT evaluates school facilities in 15 areas and an overall “good repair” rating is determined according to the following standards:

**Teacher Vacancies & Credentialing**

Teacher vacancies are monitored during the first semester of the 2021-22 school year.

[AB 1219](#) changed the reporting requirements for the CA Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC). Now, all schools are monitored for teacher credentialing and missassignments, not just Williams Case selected schools. Credential information is analyzed by the CCTC under the new process for collecting data through the CA Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) and then transferring that data into the CA Statewide Assignment Accountability System (CalSAAS) where the information will be reported.

## Summary of Findings

Based upon the 2013 Base API results, there were 44 schools in 10 school districts that were selected for instructional materials and facilities monitoring that required physical inspections. Two of those schools closed in June 2018 and 1 school closed in 2021 reducing the number of schools to 41 in 10 districts. The 41 schools had a combined 2021-22 enrollment of 27,303. Instructional materials and facilities monitoring was conducted during fall 2021 based upon a list of Deciles 1-3 schools according to 2013 Base API scores as provided by the California Department of Education.
