PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Town of Los Gatos supports the Santa Clara County Board of Education's commitment to supporting the arts to inspire and prepare students for success in the 21st century, and allowing them to develop as productive, contributing members of a strong community; and

WHEREAS, Artspiration is a county-wide arts education initiative focused on ensuring that students have access to high-quality arts education that is culturally relevant and inclusive in all forms as part of a comprehensive education that sparks curiosity, imagination, creativity, and joy; and


WHEREAS, arts learning strategies and arts integration help teachers to recognize and build upon critical thinking skills, curiosity, flexibility, communication, innovation, collaboration, and are the traits required for post-secondary and workplace success; and

WHEREAS, each March, Arts Education is celebrated in local schools, school districts, community arts organizations, and larger communities; and

WHEREAS, Youth Arts Month encourages commitment to the arts by students, community organizations, and individuals, and promotes arts education as an essential component in school curricula.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, I, Rob Moore, by the virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Los Gatos, do deem it appropriate and do hereby proclaim March 2026 as Youth Arts Month and support arts education in Santa Clara County and encourage arts in our classrooms to celebrate students' creativity, inspiration, and joy through artistic expression.
