



**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING NATIONAL PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION FOUNDER'S DAY**

**SANTA CLARA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**  
**RESOLUTION No. 2678-2**

**WHEREAS**, February 17 is Founder's Day of the National Parent Teacher Association (PTA), with the first chartered association established in 1897 in the state of New York. This year marks the 129th anniversary; and

**WHEREAS**, Founder's Day celebrates the legacy and work of the founders of the PTA: Alice McLellan Birney, Phoebe Apperson Hearst, and Selena Sloan Butler. The original mission of the PTA was to better the lives of every child in education, health, and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, today the PTA is chartered in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Europe, the Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico. California chartered its PTA in 1902; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Clara is represented by California's Sixth District PTA, chartered on February 9, 1916, and is among 28 PTA districts in the state of California. The mission of the Sixth District PTA is to impact the lives of all children and families positively; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sixth District PTA, encompasses Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, San Benito, and Monterey Counties. Sixth District PTA serves approximately 225 PTA Units. The Sixth District PTA is made up of nine PTA councils: Cupertino-Fremont-Sunnyvale, Evergreen, Los Altos-Mountain View, Milpitas Unified, Monterey Bay, North Valley, Palo Alto, San José Unified, and Santa Clara Unified; and

**WHEREAS**, Parent Teacher Associations are committed to being a powerful voice for all children, being a relevant resource for parents, and being a strong advocate for public education; and

**WHEREAS**, the Santa Clara County Office of Education facilitates and supports districts in the development of equitable parent leadership and voice that meaningfully contributes to district and school governance and the academic growth of all students; now

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Santa Clara County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools do hereby adopt this resolution to recognize February 17 as Founder's Day of the National Parent Teacher Association (PTA).
