

SANTA CLARA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

**ORDER OF ELECTION, SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER AND
CONSOLIDATION REQUEST
RESOLUTION No. 2442-2**

WHEREAS, a Biennial Governing Board Member Election has been ordered to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the Santa Clara County Board of Education of Santa Clara County for the purpose of electing:

Four (4) members for a length of term of four (4) years each of the Governing Board of the Santa Clara County Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 3 (commencing with Section 10400) of the Elections Code of the State of California and Section 5342 of the Education Code of the State of California, such election may be either completely or partially consolidated; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5322 of the Education Code of the State of California, this Board must adopt a resolution constituting a “Specifications of the Election Order”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 5322 of the Education Code and Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Governing Body of the Santa Clara County Office of Education calls for an election to be held on November 5, 2024 and requests the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County to completely consolidate the election with the statewide election.

Section 2. That the Governing Body of the Santa Clara County Office of Education requests the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County to hold and conduct the election in the manner prescribed in Section 10418 of the Elections Code of the State of California and to further provide that the Registrar of Voters canvass the returns of the election.

Section 3. That pursuant to Section 10508 of the Elections Code of the State of California, said officers are to be elected and that the divisions, if any, from which said governing board members are to be elected, and the number of offices to be filled from each, are:

Trustee Area 1	1 Office
Trustee Area 3	1 Office
Trustee Area 4	1 Office
Trustee Area 5	1 Office

Section 4. That pursuant to Sections 10002 and 10520 of the Elections Code and Section 5421 of the Education Code of the State of California, each district involved in a district general election in an affected county shall reimburse the county for the actual costs incurred by the county elections official in conducting the district general election for that district.

Section 5. That pursuant to Section 10514 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the qualifications for election to said offices, as prescribed by the principal act, are:

Any person, regardless of gender or ethnicity, who is 18 years of age or older, a registered voter, a resident within the trustee area of which he/she intends to run. Candidates cannot be employed by the Santa Clara County Office of Education (SCCOE) or any school district in the county while serving on the Board.

Section 6. That the candidate's statements of qualifications shall be limited to 200 words; that the cost of printing, translating and distributing said statements shall be borne by the candidates who file such statements; and that each candidate who files such a statement shall be required to pay in advance his or her pro rata share of the estimated costs of printing, handling, and mailing said candidate statement, such estimated costs to be determined by the Registrar of Voters.

Section 7. That pursuant to Section 10522 of the Elections Code of the State of California, a current map showing the boundaries of the district and the boundaries of the divisions of the district is herewith submitted.

Section 8. That pursuant to Section 5304 of the Education Code and Section 15651 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the method of determining the winner or winners in the event of a tie vote shall be by lot.

Section 9. That the names of all current Board Members and date each term ends are:

Area 1: Palo Alto Unified, Los Altos Union, Mountain View Whisman, Mountain View-Los Altos Union High School Districts, as well as a majority portion of Sunnyvale School District, and corresponding portions of Fremont Union High School District	
Don Rocha	2024
Area 3: Cambrian, Campbell Union, Luther Burbank, Moreland, Union and Campbell Union High School Districts, as well as small portions of San Jose Unified and Santa Clara Unified.	
Joseph Di Salvo	2024
Area 4: Majority portion of San Jose Unified, a portion of Oak Grove School District, as well as a corresponding portion of East Side Union High School District.	
Victoria Chon	2024
Area 5: Majority portion of Santa Clara Unified, Milpitas Unified, Orchard, Berryessa Union, as well as a very small portion of Alum Rock Union School Districts, and corresponding portions of East Side Union High School District.


