

**RESOLUTION
AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR AB 424– A BILL TO REPEAL THE LOOPHOLE ALLOWING CIVILIANS TO
BRING GUNS INTO SCHOOLS**

**SANTA CLARA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
RESOLUTION No. 2207-2**

WHEREAS, in 2015, the California State Legislature recognized that civilians should not bring guns into primary and secondary schools and enacted Senate Bill 707 which prohibits a person with a concealed carry permit from carrying a firearm into a public or private K-12 school; and

WHEREAS, there is a loophole in the law that still allows school districts to let specified civilians bring a gun into a school; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Santa Clara County Board of Education that, regardless of the loophole, civilians may not bring guns onto SCCOE campuses; and

WHEREAS, allowing anyone except law enforcement or licensed security guards to carry guns in schools puts children at risk of unintentional shootings and makes law enforcement’s job more difficult; and

WHEREAS, AB 424 will strengthen California’s gun laws to keep guns out of sensitive places like our schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Clara County Board of Education and County Superintendent of Schools does hereby adopt this resolution to affirm support for AB 424 – A Bill to Repeal the Loophole Allowing Civilians to Bring Guns into Schools.


