Phonological awareness is explored through several interactive games aimed at pre-kindergarten through second grade students. A "cootie catcher" activity can be used to encourage reading and writing sight words. Vowel combinations, phonics and decoding, and speech and reading accuracy are also examined in Reading Foundational Skills.</p> <p>PBS-SoCal: Kids Lab</p> <p>(Links to an external site.)</p> <p>Using games, apps, videos, and simple at-home activities, kids can take a journey that builds math and reading skills.
