VII. NEW BUSINESS

A. REVISION OF CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATIONS: MANAGER - DISTRICT BUSINESS SERVICES (CL MGMT) AND DISTRICT BUSINESS ADVISOR (CL SUPV)

MOTION #421-3 by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Gervase to revise classification specifications belonging to Manager - District Business Services, including a title change to Senior District Business Advisor and revise classification specifications belonging to District Business Advisor. Salary for the Senior District Business Advisor to remain status quo at LT-Classified Management, Range 13 (\$106,779 - \$136,281 annually). Salary for the District Business Advisor to be elevated from LT-Classified Supervisory, Range 11 (\$96,852 - \$123,610 annually) to LT-Classified Supervisory, Range 12 (\$101,695 - \$129,791 annually), effective November 1, 2014. **MOTION #421-3** carried unanimously.

B. REVISION OF CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATIONS: MANAGER - PAYROLL SERVICES (CL MGMT)

MOTION #421-4 by Mr. Gervase, seconded by Mr. Martin to revise classification specifications belonging to Manager - Payroll Services. Salary for the Manager - Payroll Services to remain status quo at LT-Classified Management, Range 10 (\$92,240 - 117,725 annually), effective October 8, 2014. **MOTION #421-4** carried unanimously.
