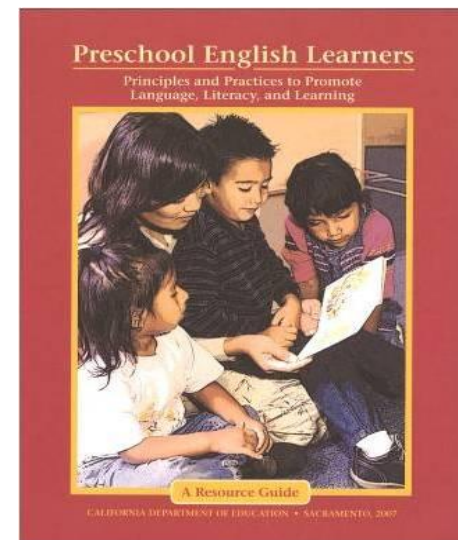
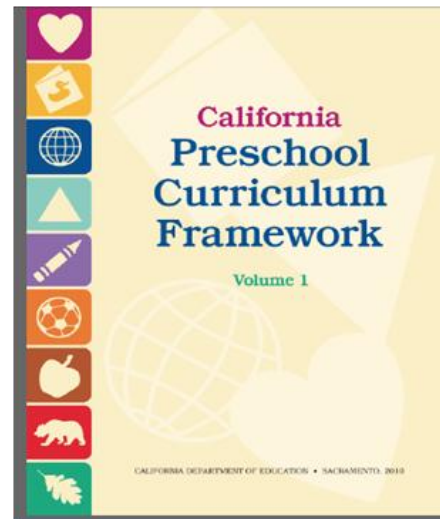
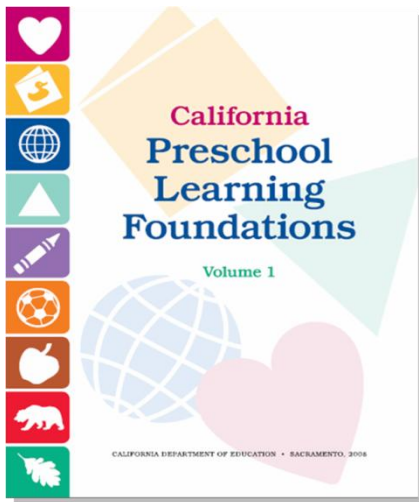
What is the purpose of CPIN?
