Welcome back to another fantastic year of school. We are very excited to start the 2022-2023 school year and are writing to keep you informed of our student testing availability.

For the 2022-2023 school year, we will continue to have our Site Based Testing for students. Our traveling testing team provides rapid antigen testing. This means you can get online access to your test results in as few as 15 minutes and at most 45 minutes! You must be registered in [Primary Health](#) to participate in this testing. Please see the Site-Based Testing schedule [here](#). You may visit any location as long as you are registered. Please remember to register first!

Student testing will also be offered on site at our community schools daily.

Additionally, we will continue to supply weekly iHealth tests. Each box contains two tests. We encourage all families to test weekly. We also encourage testing prior to returning from all school breaks. All positive test results must be communicated to your school's site principal or site-director. If you are in need of an at home test, please contact your site administrator.

IMPORTANT!

- Testing is not required, however, it is highly recommended to test weekly.
- Testing is for SCCOE students only.
- If you are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, please stay home and contact your health care provider immediately as well as your school's office.
- It is possible to have an active COVID-19 virus infection and be contagious without having symptoms (asymptomatic).
