## Handout for the Regional Assessment Network—May 18, 2016

### English Language Proficiency Assessments (ELPA) Office California Department of Education (CDE)

The ELPA Office is responsible for the development and administration of the California English Language Development Test (CELDT), the English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC), and the successor to the Standards-based Tests in Spanish.

#### ELPAC

- In March 2016, Educational Testing Service (ETS) provided the CDE with a complete report of the pilot test results.
- Domain- and Grade/Grade Span-Specific Performance Level Descriptor Meetings are scheduled to occur in Sacramento on June 14 and June 16, 2016.
- The CDE is currently reviewing 2,000 draft ELPAC test items.
- Content Review Panel and Bias and Sensitivity Review Panel Meetings are scheduled to occur in Sacramento from August 1 to August 5, 2016
- **2016–17 Educator Opportunities for Involvement in the Development of the ELPAC**
  - There are four educator opportunities available during the 2016–17 school year. See the online application at the link below for more specific details. All meetings will be held in Sacramento.
