The coinsurance percentage will increase by 10% each year (to a maximum of 100%) for each enrollee if that person visits the dentist at least once during the calendar year. If an enrollee becomes ineligible for benefits and later regains eligibility, the percentage will drop back to 70%. Prosthodontic services pay at 100% and are not subject to the incentives.
