

How many of us feel like this when calling anywhere for assistance and get bounced back and forth?




Project

- * This project is important to me because I enjoy my job and finding new ways to make it easier and end up with a happy family at the end of the day...its rewarding to me.


Accomplishments/Successes

Accomplishments/Successes


While working on this project I have created a flow chart which is the initial step in assisting families to determine their eligibility:
