(POST ON WEBSITE AND AT ALL SCHOOL ENTRANCES)

VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.

FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

All teachers and staff are given cloth and disposable surgical masks. Resupply is upon request with no restrictions. Students are given a surgical mask if they arrive on campus without a mask. Signs are placed throughout buildings illustrating the proper way to wear a mask and reminding all students and staff to wear their mask at all times. We are not allowing visitors to our campus at this time.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

All classrooms and offices have desks and learning/teaching/working spaces distanced by a minimum of 6ft from each other. Signs are placed throughout buildings illustrating and encouraging 6ft of distance from others. We are not allowing visitors to our campus at this time.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

We have full-time custodial staff who clean and maintain our campus daily. This includes disinfecting high-touch areas and spraying GenEon once per week in all occupied areas. All staff have access to cleaning supplies and have been instructed on their use.

HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Signage throughout campus, to include inside classrooms and office areas, illustrate the proper way to wash hands. Available sinks and soap are available. Hand sanitizer is available in all occupied spaces. Once a space is occupied it is stocked with hand sanitizer and signage prior to occupancy.

ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

All staff are encouraged to get tested once per month. Testing opportunities are offered at the Santa Clara County Office of Education. Once per month testing at the site-level will be offered beginning in December 2020.

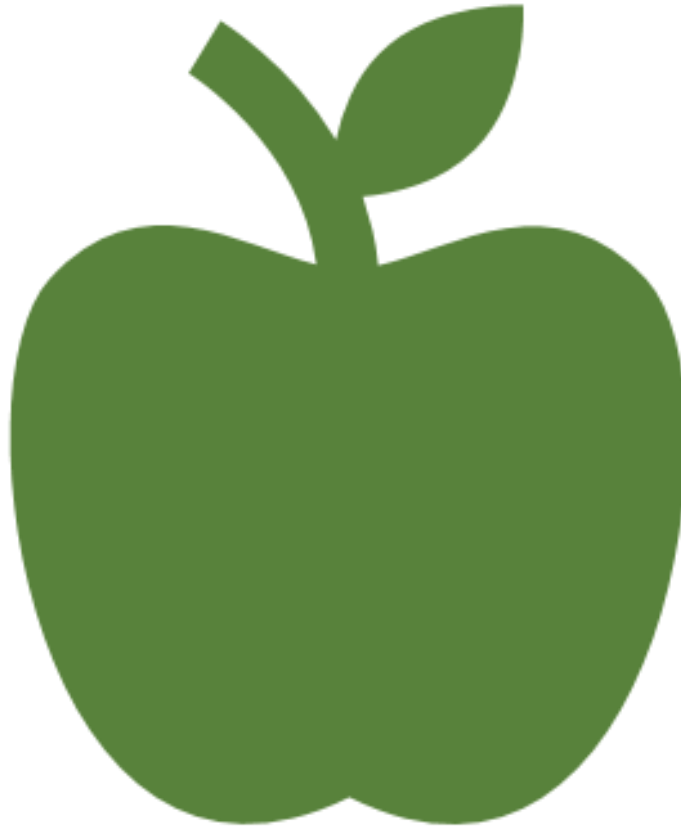
- **Families are required to report known cases of COVID-19 in their household to the school immediately. The school will report all known COVID-19 cases to Santa Clara Public Health.**
