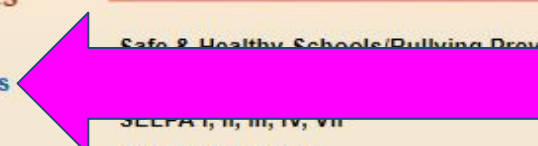

- all templates **must** meet the ADA Section 508 requirements
- There is no Spanish translated versions yet

CDE Template Choices

Word Template

- must use “Approved LCAP Template 2018”
- Meets ADA requirements
- Must copy/paste into latest version of template

eTemplate

- contact Dawn River for LEA Coordinator access
- multiple people can work on document
- district controls access to document
- document rolled to next year
- Meets ADA requirements



Other Template Choices

LACOE Template

- electronic template
- can be used for free
- meets ADA requirements
- district controls access to document
- document rolled to next year

DTS (Document Tracking)

- electronic template
- fee based system
- meets ADA requirements
- district controls access to document
- document rolled to next year

LCAP Suggested Timeline

- March/April
 - LEAs should complete Annual Update
 - analysis of Update to determine any modifications to 18-19 goals/actions/services
 - Stakeholder engagement
- April/May
 - modifications to goals/actions/services as needed for 18-19 plan
 - stakeholder engagement
 - Draft of LCAP Addendum



LCAP Suggested Timeline

- May/June
 - **draft to SCCOE support person for feedback before taking before Board
 - Completion of LCAP Addendum
 - LCAP Public Hearing
 - LCAP Board Adoption
 - Board Approved LCAP to SCCOE by June 30

- no changes to any parts of the 2017-18 section of the document (copy & paste only)

Goals/Actions & Services

- should address all 8 state priorities
- address any new red or orange groups

** Be sure to read and follow all directions on the template

- CDE released the template on 3/26
- Any LEA that receives Title I-IV funds **must** complete the addendum
- There is no timeline for submission yet
- There are no guidelines for completing & submitting the document yet
- The completed document will be submitted to CDE who will approve/not approve
