Q) How do I make a payment?

A) To make a payment, please log-into your [CAESAR](#) account, and proceed to pay the appropriate fees with your credit or debit card. All payments should be submitted at least one week prior to the due date.

Q) Do you offer financial aid?

A) The EPIC Credentialing Program does not currently offer financial aid. While we don't offer financial aid, we are very affordable compared to other programs, and at times are able to offer certain grant opportunities. Currently, we do have a special grant program called Earn One Add One, which is in partnership with San Jose State University, The East Side Alliance, Silicon Valley Education Foundation, New Teaching Center and 21 school districts. This grant is for general education teachers and paraeducators.
