K-12 Environmental Connections to Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS)



K-12 Environmental Connections to NGSS provides grade-appropriate learning experiences to deepen understanding of the Next Generation Science Standards and their connections to the Environmental Principles and Concepts (EPCs).

During this two-day training, participants will experience a learning sequence focused on environmental phenomena based on work from the California State NGSS collaborative. They will also explore planning lessons based on local phenomena. In addition, community partners will share their resources to help support student learning through environmental literacy.

We encourage districts to send teams of four to six members representing teacher leaders, academic coaches, curriculum leads, Teachers on special assignments (TOSAs), and at least one administrator.

The California Department of Education and the California County Superintendents Educational Service Association sponsored this curriculum.
