SAN JOSE, CA – The Santa Clara County Board of Education (SCCBOE) will co-sponsor a San Jose Mayoral Candidates' Forum on Education from 10 a.m. to noon on Saturday, May 10 at the Mexican Heritage Plaza (Pavilion), 1700 Alum Rock Avenue, San Jose, CA 95116.

Moderated by Dr. Terry Christensen, Professor Emeritus at San Jose State University, the forum will address the educational needs of children and families across the city and provide voters with an opportunity to hear where the candidates stand on topics ranging from early education to the quality and results of the public school system.
