School Districts, teaching candidates will meet at 2015 Recruitment Fair

SAN JOSE, CA – The Santa Clara County Office of Education's annual Teacher Recruitment Fair will be held on Saturday, March 28 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at its Ridder Park office.

This is the 28th year that the Teacher Recruitment Fair has introduced job-hunters to potential employers from districts across the county. It provides candidates with the opportunity for one-stop shopping in their job hunt, and presents districts with a wide array of potential employees who already have their qualifications in hand.

Over a thousand qualified credentialed candidates register for the fair each year, where more than 300 school district and charter school administrators meet with prospective employees in the hopes of filling open teaching positions.

The event will feature on-site interviews, recruiters from multiple districts, credential specialists and a resource guide on Santa Clara County school districts and charter schools. To attend, candidates must have a preliminary clear credential or have worked as an intern for one year.

Typically, about 300 countywide positions are filled each year as a result of the fair.

Jobs in high demand throughout the county include those for speech pathologists, special education teachers, bilingual educators and teachers in the subjects of math and science.

The County Office of Education will be looking for teachers for students with severe disabilities, emotional disturbances, autism, orthopedic impairments, and hearing and visual impairments.
