Equitable & Engaging Pedagogy in Practice






TUPE's Parent Education Night

Teacher Residency Program

SCCOE's Teacher Residency Program prepares and supports effective teachers in our local community. In one year, Teacher Residents engage in coursework two nights per week while spending at least three full days per week in a mentor's classroom. To increase teacher workforce diversity and decrease vacancies in hard-to-hire areas, residents receive a \$25,000 grant in exchange for a commitment to 4 years of teaching service in Santa Clara County.
