# Kindergarten through Twelfth Grade Energy Efficiency Program

The Energy Conservation Assistance Act - Education (ECAA-Ed) program offers zero-interest-rate loans for eligible energy projects at public school facilities. The maximum loan is \$3 million for energy efficiency and energy generation projects, or \$5 million for projects with electric vehicle charging infrastructure and/or energy storage systems.

Who is eligible?

- · Public School Districts
- Charter Schools
- · County Offices of Education
- State Special Schools

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until all the funds are awarded.
