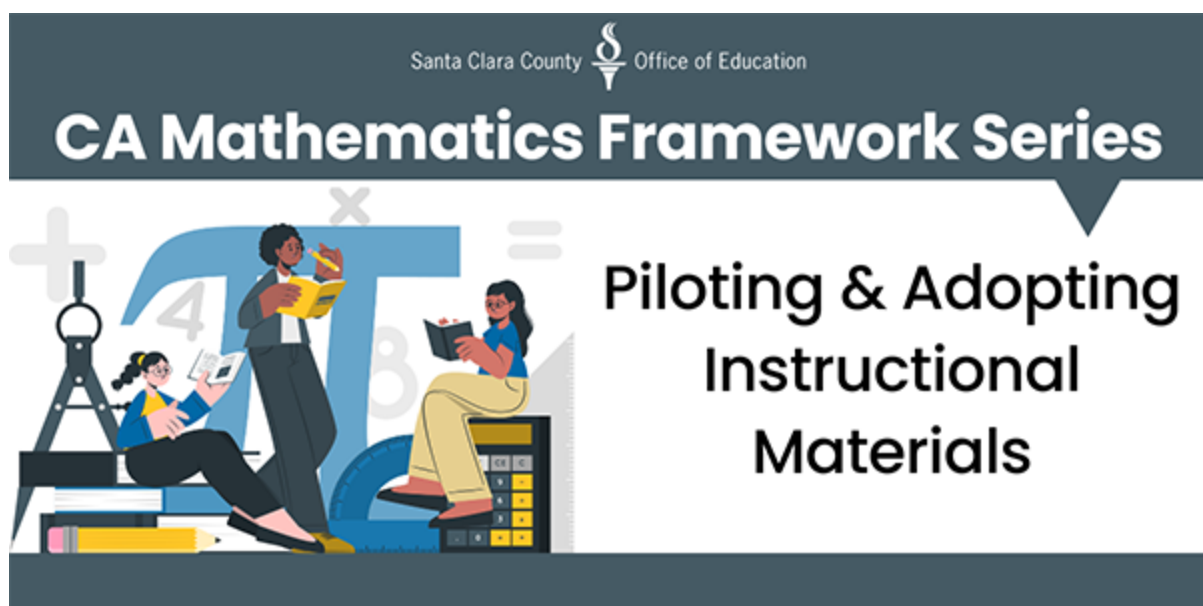


## Professional Development

## Professional Development Highlight

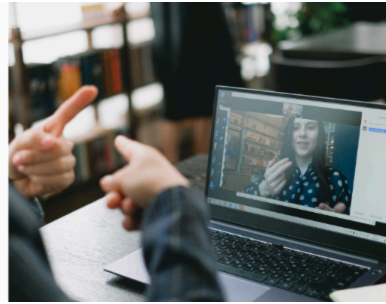


As LEAs across California pilot and adopt new math materials, the real opportunity lies in using curriculum as a catalyst for meaningful instructional shifts. This series

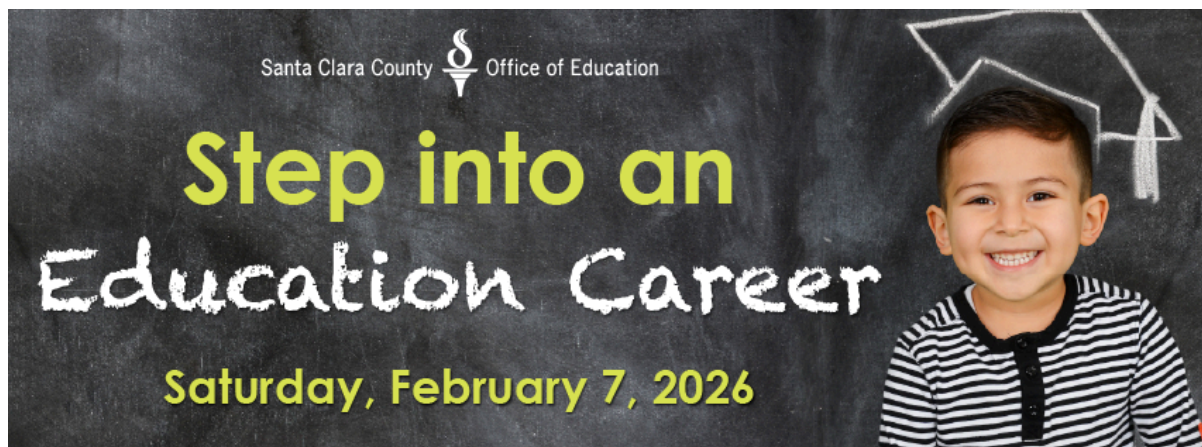


### **Santa Clara County Office of Education American Sign Language (ASL) Community Class Survey**
