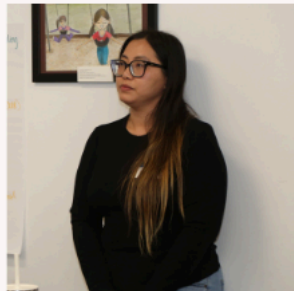
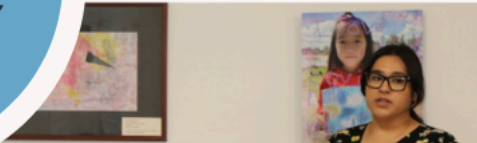

Applications are now open for the SCCOE School Counselor Residency Program’s second cohort, an affordable pathway to earn your Master of Arts in Counseling and Pupil Personnel Services Credential in School Counseling in just 18 months.
