August is just days away, and with the new month comes a new school year. Although it is not the typical start to school, I am looking forward to an incredibly positive and successful year. School employees, school leaders, elected officials and others have been preparing for the next school year and the planned return to full in-person instruction. Schools are ready.

While many families are also excited and ready for full-time reconnection for their children, others are anxious or unsure about potential risks. The school districts in Santa Clara County are committed to the health and wellness of the students, staff, and their families. Schools will continue to foster resilience, perseverance, and the ability to communicate effectively in diverse learning situations.


Women's Equality Day Event
