a) Curriculum Alignment with Back-on-Track Model – presenter, Phil Morales, and Dr. Everett SIATECH has notified they will be transitioning to a new curriculum and will not extend the current contract. We have created a Curriculum Council to research new online curriculums that is aligned with OYA’s back-on-track model in our charter and very important that it aligns to the Career and College readiness mission. The Curriculum Committee was thorough with several online curriculum. Their findings found Edgenuity to align most closely with our back-on-track model specifically in career technical education. And we found Edgenuity also provide a wide choice of courses providing social emotional learning for students. Edgenuity My path directly links to Ren Star which helps and aligns students to move through their lessons based on their math and reading scores.

b) Student Performance, Enrollment, and Attendance Data Presentation – presenter, Phil Morales Overall increase of students that met or exceeded CAASP ELA. The is a significantly growth from previous years. There has been progress in our ELPAC exams showing English Learners students’ growth. Our enrollments are currently at 371. We are very close to reaching maximum enrollment at 380. Because of the re-engagement tier strategies implemented student attendance has increased and keeping students engaged and excited about their academic. Lastly, we have seven students enrolled at MetroEd taking CTE courses and they have a 100% attendance in both MetroEd and OYA.


