a) College and Career Update – Phil Morales Presented

Mr. Morales provided an update presentation on Opportunity Youth Academy’s college and career support services on readiness and students’ progress toward transitioning to post-secondary opportunities. Currently there are seven students dually enrolled at De Anza College for Spring quarter. We are proud to share that 45% of our total graduates have transitioned to a community college or trade school. For many they are the first in their families to enroll in college. These support services ties into our LCAP goal #3; all students will leave prepared for a successful transition to college and/or career because of premier programs services and curriculum. We are establishing an Advisory CTE Committee with the Professional Learning & Instructional Support Division.

b) Continuous Improvement Year One – Dr. Everett presented

Dr. Everett presented on year one of OYA’s Individual Learning Plan (ILP) advisory sessions which are held quarterly with teachers and their students to review a student’s academic progress and other non-related school needs which is related to our first goal in our LCAP; all students will participate in a rigorous relevant and engaging instruction. To guide the learning as we implemented the targeted changes we used the Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) cycle.
