- 1. Welcome, Introductions, Announcements, and Minutes Mary Ann Burke, Santa Clara COE Introductions were made and Mary Ann reviewed the meeting agenda and minutes of the September 29, 2011 meeting.
- 2. Parent Engagement Initiative Updates Mary Ann Burke, Santa Clara COE

Mary Ann provided an update on activities including the October 8 and October 29, 2011 Parent Conferences and the trainer-of-trainer workshops scheduled during the school year.
