Grades TK-3

This series will focus on instructional planning that enables teachers to use high leverage instructional strategies to increase content understanding and English language proficiency for students in K-12. Each session includes modeling of tech tools, engaging in a strategy, seeing what it looks like in action, as well as considerations for synchronous and asynchronous teaching and learning.

During the TK-3 series, we engage in the following strategies:

- Close Reading (*guides understanding of complex text, increases rigor with DOK levels, and builds students' habits of inquiry*)
- Pictorial Input Chart (*build knowledge and disciplinary vocabulary through visuals, labels, and gestures*)
- Sentence Patterning (*increases students' language, expands and enriches their ideas in order to write more complex sentences*)
- Writing about an Experience (*develop skills to describe setting and character, details, plot, dialogue and sequence*)
