Early learning is the foundation for future success.

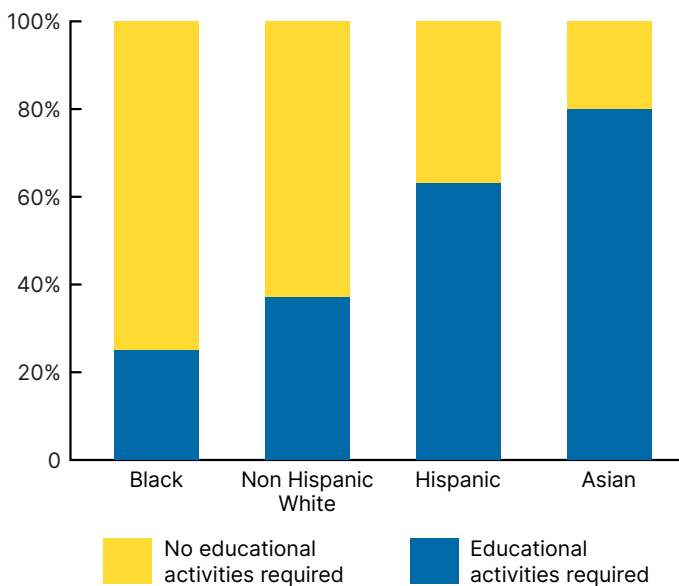
By itself, high-quality early learning can eliminate **20% of the achievement gap** and **100% of the graduation gap** between high and low-income students.



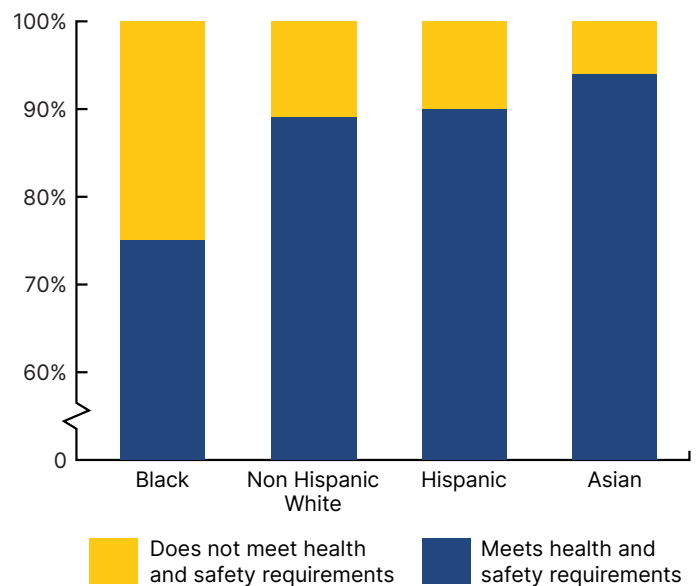
Students who attend high-quality full-day preschool are **40% more likely to read at grade level.**



Enrollment by race/ethnicity and whether program requires educational activities



Enrollment by race/ethnicity and whether setting meets health & safety requirements



Pre-K children are expelled at **3x the rate** of K-12 children.

Black children are expelled **2x more often** than their peers.



2/3 of children in childcare deserts are Hispanic.



Only **37% of preschool children** with an IEP are served in an inclusive setting.

AB 568 would:

Increase access to existing and new information that will help state and local policy makers make informed decisions about where to invest new resources.

Identify existing gaps and inequities in access to early learning and care programs.

Utilize existing infrastructure to create a complaint process to report discrimination and exclusion.
