

AB 2206 (ADDIS) - REMOVING BARRIERS TO CHILDCARE FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

Would remove outdated regulatory barriers that prevent children with disabilities from accessing inclusive early learning and childcare options.

AB 2176 (BERMAN) - ENSURING EDUCATIONAL ACCESS FOR JUVENILES

Would ensure that students' constitutional right to an equitable education is not denied or arbitrarily withheld during incarceration while still maintaining safety of peers and staff.



SB 1318 (WAHAB) - STUDENTS EXPERIENCING A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS

Would require school suicide prevention plans to include protocols for addressing a student mental health crisis in a way that prioritizes use of mental health professionals rather than law enforcement.



AB 1930 (REYES) - SUSTAINING THE CHILDCARE WORKFORCE

Would sustain the childcare workforce and help address staffing shortages in childcare by allowing Associate Teachers to renew their child development permit upon completion of continuing education.



SB 999 (CORTESE) - MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS

Would ensure that Californians suffering from mental health and substance use disorders receive the level of treatment necessary by creating standards for health plans' utilization decisions.



SB 333 (CORTESE) – GUARANTEED INCOME FOR HOMELESS YOUTH

Would provide guaranteed income to 12th grade students experiencing homelessness to support their transition from high school to employment and postsecondary education.
