**AB 2206 (ADDIS) – REMOVING BARRIERS TO CHILDCARE FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES**

Would remove outdated regulatory barriers that prevent children with disabilities from accessing inclusive early learning and childcare options.

**2176**

**AB 2176 (BERMAN) – ENSURING EDUCATIONAL ACCESS FOR JUVENILES**

Would ensure that students' constitutional right to an equitable education is not denied or arbitrarily withheld during incarceration while still maintaining safety of peers and staff.

**1318**

**SB 1318 (WAHAB) – STUDENTS EXPERIENCING A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS**

Would require school suicide prevention plans to include protocols for addressing a student mental health crisis in a way that prioritizes use of mental health professionals rather than law enforcement.

**1930**

**AB 1930 (REYES) – SUSTAINING THE CHILDCARE WORKFORCE**

Would sustain the childcare workforce and help address staffing shortages in childcare by allowing Associate Teachers to renew their child development permit upon completion of continuing education.

**999**

**SB 999 (CORTESE) – MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS**

Would ensure that Californians suffering from mental health and substance use disorders receive the level of treatment necessary by creating standards for health plans' utilization decisions.

**333**

**SB 333 (CORTESE) – GUARANTEED INCOME FOR HOMELESS YOUTH**

Would provide guaranteed income to 12<sup>th</sup> grade students experiencing homelessness to support their transition from high school to employment and postsecondary education.
