

Transitional Kindergarten Teacher (General Education or Special Education)

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is part of the K-12 public school system and is the first year of a two-year kindergarten program that uses a modified kindergarten curriculum that is age and developmentally appropriate. TK must be taught by an educator who holds a teaching credential <u>(Source: CTC)</u>.

EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Teaching Credential + 24 units of Early Care and Education or Child Development.
