#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE**

Certified Wellness Coaches (CWC) provide care to young people through prevention and early intervention services. Thes services support overall physical, emotional, and mental well-being.

- Professionalism, ethics, and legal mandates
- Communication
- Operating in different roles and environments

### **EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

The CWC Workforce Pathway is for those currently working in mental health, substance use/addiction, social work, or child welfare. They also need to have an associate's or bachelor's degree in a related field.

The CWC Education Program Pathway is for prospective applicants that are newly enrolled, currently enrolled, or recently graduated.
