What is the event schedule for the October 24 Teacher Recognition Celebration?

- SCCOE staff will confirm RSVP, and direct you to the reception area to await instructions for the dress rehearsal.
- The hors d'oeuvres reception will begin at 6:00 p.m. The awards ceremony will run from 7:00 p.m. to (approximately) 8:30 p.m.
- **Honorees and presenters** should plan on arriving by 4:30 p.m. for a 30-minute rehearsal and group photograph. **This is very important!** After the rehearsal is completed, you'll join friends, families, and colleagues for the hors d'oeuvres reception.
- Following the hors d'oeuvres reception you will be directed to sit in reserved seating. Your guests will be seated separately.
- **Guests** should plan to be seated in the theatre by **6:55 p.m.**, doors will open at 6:45 p.m.

Will I be able to sit with my friends/family?

• There will be reserved seating for honorees to allow easy stage access. Everyone else can sit where they like in the theater.

- Your guest will not be permitted to sit with you in this area.
- There is plenty of seating available inside the Heritage Theatre.

Do I have to talk at the event?

• **No.** During the event, honorees will walk on stage to receive their award; no public speaking is required.

What should I wear?

• It is a celebratory event - semi-formal or professional attire.

Where should I park?

 The event is held at the Campbell Heritage Theatre, 1 W. Campbell Avenue, Campbell, CA 95008. Ample parking is available in a lot near the Campbell Community Center, which adjoins the theatre.
