# What is TUPE?

- Tobacco Use Prevention Education (TUPE) is a comprehensive evidencebased program for students in grades 6th through 12th.
- The purpose is to reduce youth tobacco-use through classroom-based curriculum, youth engagement activities, one-on-one intervention support, and cessation support through referrals and quit groups.
- TUPE is endorsed by the California Department of Education and the California Department of Public Health Tobacco Control Branch.
- Funding originates from tobacco tax revenue; CA Prop 99 & 56.



## About

The program teaches students to become leaders in offering peer-to-peer support to spread the tobacco and drug-free message on campus.

# **Program Goals**

- 1. Be informed with a goal to education your peers about the harms of vaping, tobacco, and cannabis use during the 2022-23 school year.
- 2. Develop skills in advocacy, public speaking, facilitation, and problem solving.
- 3. Lead your school campus to improve the health and well-being of your peers by participatin in 2 school wide tobacco awareness activities by the end of the 2022-23 school year.
