


# Find it in the Encyclopedia Worksheet

- Complete the worksheet using the sample Encyclopedia at the top of the page.




## Suggestion:



Example: Monkeys 11: 247-249

Hockey H: 150-151

Sometimes you will find additional information listed for the subject.

Example: Judo J: 75, 85-89

Karate and Judo K: 24

Olympic events O: 107
