The SCCOE will consider the totality of the circumstances concerning the project and will determine that the CONTRACTOR and the CONTRACTOR's employees may be subject to the fingerprinting requirements of Education Code Sections 45125.1 and/or 45125.2

The Santa Clara County Office of Education may create a new contractors list effective **January 1st of each year** and may include any contractor's name it desires on the contractors list, but must include at a minimum, all contractors who have properly provided the SCCOE with the required information, either during the calendar year in which the list is valid or during November or December of the prior year. The list will automatically include all contractors who submitted one or more bids to the SCCOE during the preceding year. A contractor may have their firm added to the SCCOE's contractors list at any time by providing the required information.

<u>Prequalification for Projects over \$1 million</u>: In addition to registering with the SCCOE, all General Contractors (A and B), Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Contractors (C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43, and C-46) need to complete the prequalification application in order to be eligible to work on projects in excess of \$1 million dollars.

<u>Application certification:</u> I certify that to the best of my knowledge, the elements of information provided above are accurate and true, as of this date. I am properly licensed and skilled to perform the above work and can secure bonds to perform the work. My company shall comply with city, state, and federal requirements. I certify that I am not an employee of SCCOE and that to the best of my knowledge and belief, no relative or personal relationship exists which may be a potential conflict of interest between my organization and any employee or agent of SCCOE.
