

- To expedite the processing of leases contracts and Memorandums of Understanding




 Head Start Policy Council approved new food policy on April 2011




Figure: Brain Growth and Public Investment, A Mismatch (Children Now) 2010

Conducted a charrette to make sure multiagency agreements are solidified




First 5 Santa Clara approved \$1 M
