The goal is to empower and assist care providers, parents, agencies and systems that support the youth in achieving academic success. FYS also serves as a resource and works closely with school district liaisons to make sure guidelines are implemented for Assembly Bills, [AB490](#), [AB167](#) and the [McKinney-Vento Homeless Education law](#). These laws address immediate enrollment, school stability in school of origin, transportation disputes, timely transfer of educational records, protection of credits, grades and graduation.

FYS represents a partnership among Santa Clara County's key stakeholders focused on improving the educational outcomes of wards and dependents, ages 4 to 21, residing in licensed children's institutions, foster family agency and county foster homes.
