What is E-Rate?

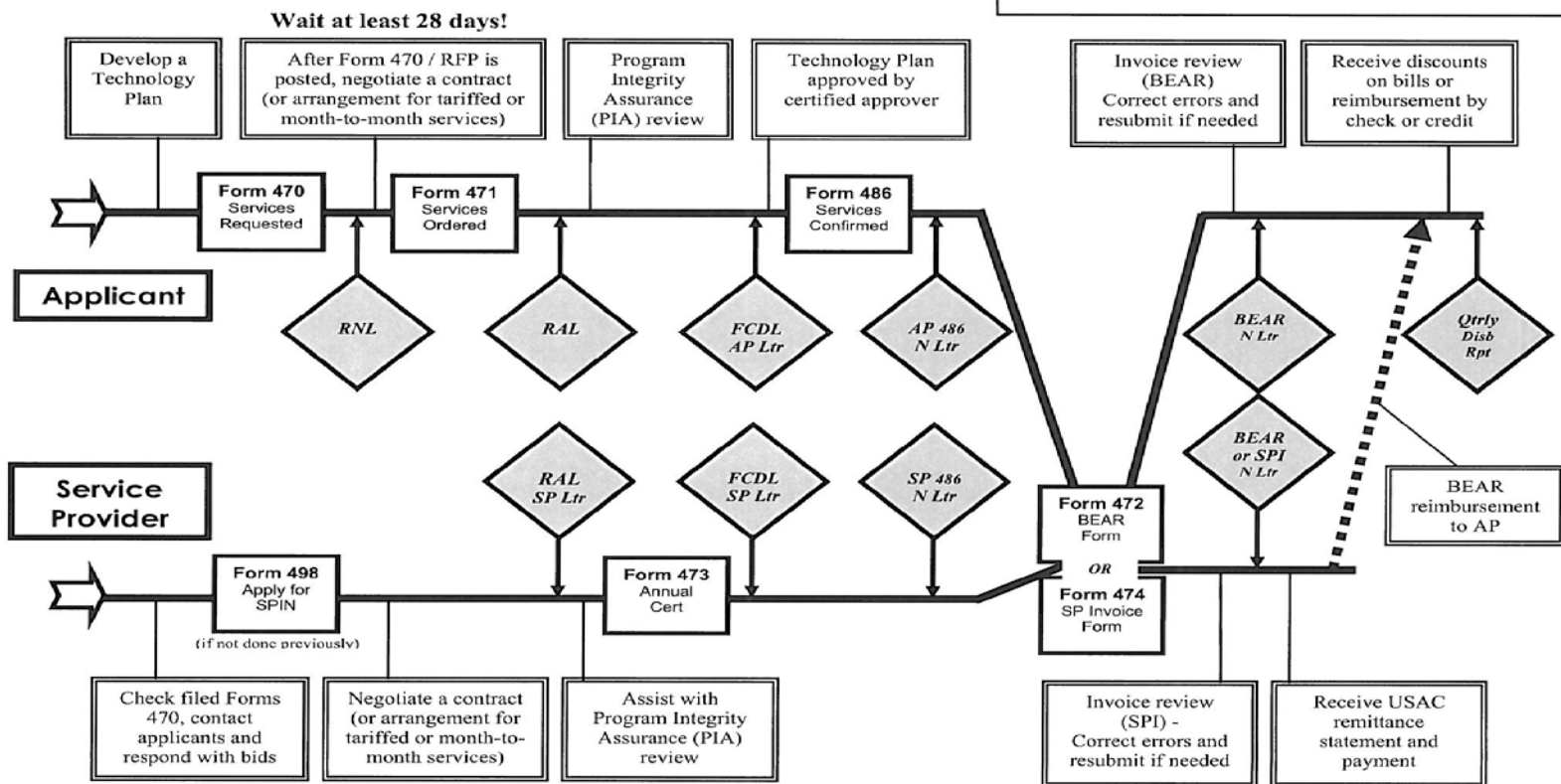
- Universal Service - School and Libraries Program
- Federal Program provides discounts of up to 90% for Telecommunications and Internet Access
- \$2.3 Billion in funding available

The E-Rate Process



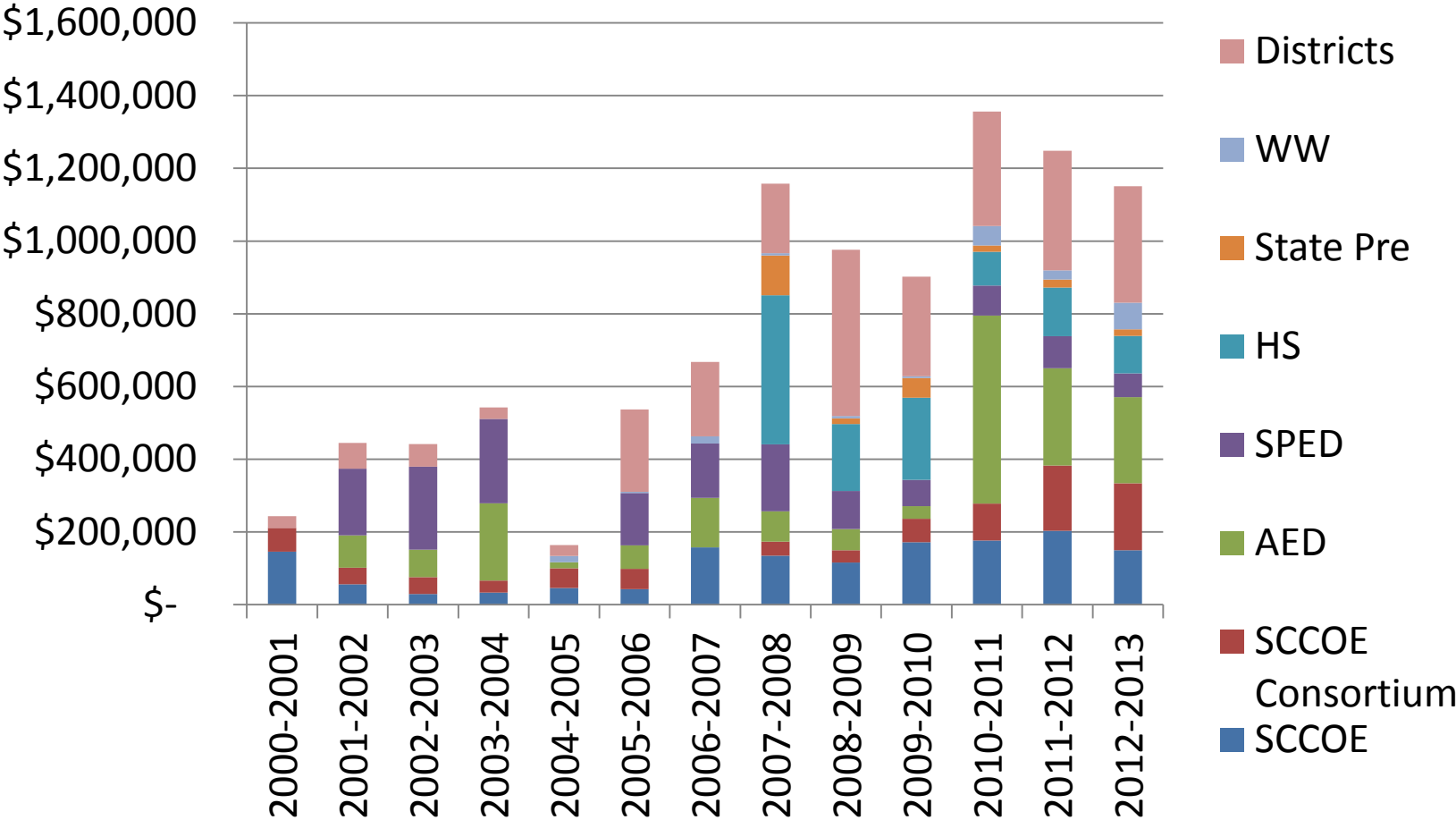
Application Process Flow Chart

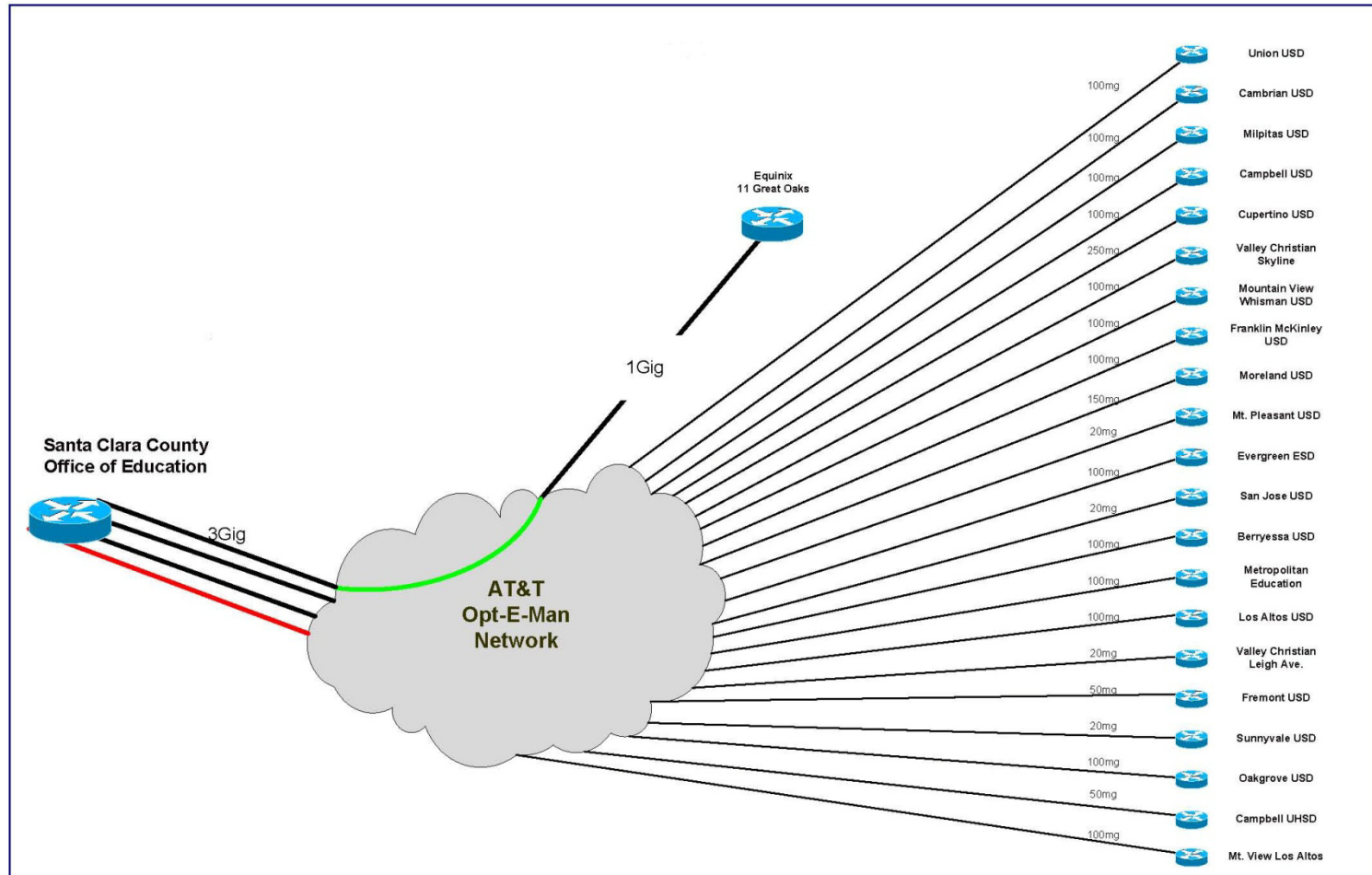
