MEP Background



- Federally funded program
- Provides supplemental educational and health services to migrant children
- Grants assist States
- Region 1 serves:
 - **9,059** students in **29** school districts in **6** counties
- Services are provided only to eligible students

- **Steps to meet goal:**

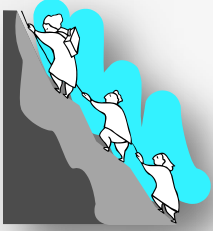
1. Met with planning committee staff (Migrant specialists and Director)
