Hello everyone,

The 19th Annual Silicon Valley Reads program returns in 2022 with the theme of **Power of Kindness, Resilience & Hope**. This theme will allow us to engage in conversation about the transformative power of kindness, highlight our remarkable capacity for resilience, and build hopefulness for our future. During February and March of 2022, Silicon Valley Reads will offer free virtual and inperson public programs for all ages, including author talks, panel discussions, educational events, demonstrations, performances, activities for students, story times, and an art exhibit.

families can begin planning for the vaccine. The Biden administration plans to distribute the doses and reports that it has procured enough vaccines for all 28 million 5 to 11 year-olds in the U.S. The vaccine for 5 to 11 year-olds will be distributed in smaller dosing and with smaller needles to make it easier for pediatricians and pharmacists to administer to children. Rent Relief

COVID-19 Rent Relief is available to Santa Clara County Residents

The COVID-19 Rent Relief Program is rental assistance for tenants who have past due rent from April 1, 2020 - September 30, 2021. Up to 3 months of future rent can be applied for and granted. 100% of rent and utilities will be covered.

Who Can Apply?

- Landlords who have income-eligible renters experiencing a financial hardship due to COVID-19 past due rent.
- Renters who have experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19, have past due rent or utilities, and have a household income that is not more than 80% of the area median income.

How Can You Apply?

For assistance in applying, eligible tenants/landlords may call Catholic Charities at (408) 273-7478 to set up an appointment.

Attend a pop-up clinic for assistance every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday or apply directly online at HousinglsKey.com.







- The second shot is three weeks after the first shot.
- Your child will get the Pfizer vaccine.
- This is the vaccine that will be available for kids ages 5 to 11.
- It is a smaller dose than the Pfizer vaccine for adults. It is one-third of an adult dose.
