A. Performance Indicator Review (PIR) Plan 2018-2019

Background

Based on data for students with disabilities, as reported in the California School Dashboard and the Local Level Annual Performance Report (Annual Performance Report or APR), the California Department of Education (CDE) has determined that Opportunity Youth Academy will participate in the 2018–19 Performance Indicator Review (Performance Indicator Review or PIR) beginning in March, 2019.

The Opportunity Youth Academy is required to complete a Performance Indicator Review Improvement Plan for Indicator #3 Assessment Participation Rate in Math and English Language Arts on the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Assessment.
