# What is a SARC?

- State and Federal laws require all public schools receiving state and federal funding to prepare and distribute a SARC.
- The purpose of the SARC is to provide parents and community with important information.

## What Information does a SARC contain?

- Background information about the school and its students
  - Demographic
  - School Safety and Climate
  - Academic Data
  - Class Sizes
  - Teacher and Staff Information
  - Curriculum
  - Facilities Conditions



### State Priorities in the SARC

- Priority 1
  - Access to Standards-aligned curriculum: 100%
  - Credentialed Teachers: 100 %
  - Maintained School Facilities:
    - Overall Good, Facilities Inspection Tool (FIT) report 9/3/2022
- Priority 4
  - Pupil Achievement
    - Statewide Assessments and Career Technical Education Programs/Participation (Data not released)
- Priority 3
  - Parental Involvement
    - School Site Council
    - LCAP Survey
    - School Engagement Events
- Priority 5
  - Pupil Engagement
    - High school dropout rates
    - High school graduation rates
- Priority 6
  - School Climate: Zero suspensions or expulsions

## How often must a SARC be updated?

 SARCs must be updated annually and published by February 1<sup>st.</sup>

• School administration reviews and updates the SARC for board approval in January.

• OYA works with Document Tracking Services to complete the mandated requirements.
