IV. ACTION ITEM

A. **Proposed 2022-23 SCCOE Special Ed Block Rates and District-SELPA Cost Share**

Deputy Supt. Stephen McMahon moved to approve the 2022-23 SCCOE Special Ed Block Rates as presented by the SCCOE Special Ed department at the Rebenching meetings, and the District-SELPA Cost Share as recommended by SELPA IV special education program and fiscal representatives. Dr. Mary Ann Dewan seconded and the motion carried, 2-0. It was also noted that for the CCS/MTU cost-share among all districts within Santa Clara SELPAs I, II, III, IV, & VII, Palo Alto Unified SD (PAUSD) has been providing 8 classrooms spaces but has only been credited for 4. Beginning 2022-23, 4 additional classroom spaces will be credited to PAUSD.
