##	to search for a number range DVD player \$50\$100

link:	Locates websites that link to a specific website. link:www.sccoe.org	
filetype:	Limits your search by filetype. filetype:pdf or filetype:ppt	
define:	Use to find the definition of a word. define:differentiation
